LEARNING OBJECTIVES

After completion of the training you will know how to use the WIRTGEN GROUP portal and the information systems it contains relevant to Customer Support and will have detailed knowledge of the use and the information contained in the respective systems.

You will understand the purpose of the WIRTGEN GROUP documentation system WIDOS and be able to confidently navigate the system, select the correct machine, call up machine documentation and navigate the spare parts catalogue to select and order correct parts and lubricants.

You will be able to open machine-specific electrical and hydraulic diagrams in WIDOS and find information from the diagrams in a targeted way. You will understand the structure of the diagrams and describe the page layout, equipment identification codes, device identification letters and colour codes and know the meaning of the different line types and symbols. You will also know how to follow links of current paths and relays and determine part numbers of cable harnesses and plug connections with WIDOS.

You will learn how to access the WIRTGEN GROUP telematics system WITOS FleetView, and be able to confidently navigate the system to be able to track and manage a fleet of machines in WITOS and call up required information, enter maintenance records and produce reports.
